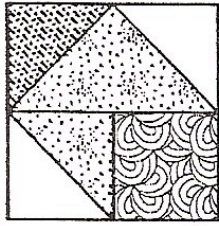
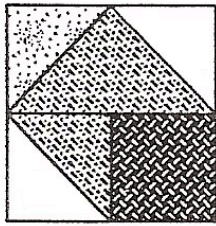


Scrappy Trails to You - Step 4

Unit H. Make 24.

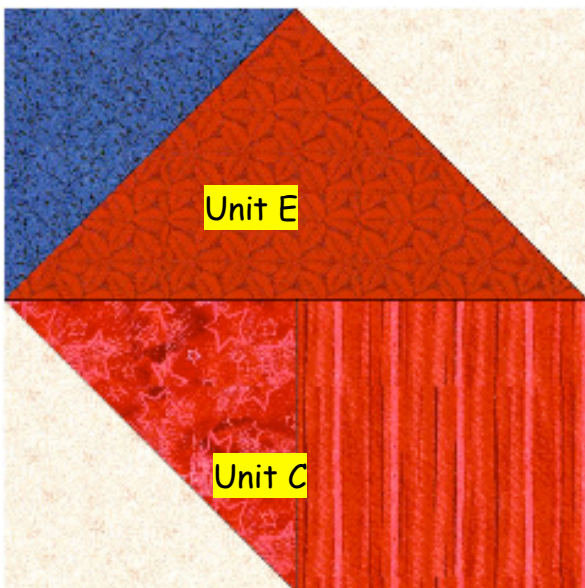
1. Join the "C" units from Step 2 and the "E" units from Step 3 to make 24 Unit G as shown. Combine the fabrics at random. Press the seams open or toward the squares. The units should measure 5-1/2" x 5-1/2" (raw edge to raw edge) when sewn.

Now join the "D" units from Step 2 and the "F" units from Step 3 to make 24 Unit H as shown. Combine the fabrics at random. Press the seams open or toward the squares. The units should measure 5-1/2" x 5-1/2" (raw edge to raw edge) when sewn.

Uhuru Challenge Notes:

- ✂ I recommend pressing toward the squares, away from the "goose" triangles.
- ✂ If you are making the lap-size, you'll need 40 units of each colorway, making 40 each of Units G and H.
- ✂ When you're done, you'll have 48 (crib-size) or 80 (lap-size) "sub-blocks." They should measure 5-1/2" (raw edges) square.
